Overview of Library

The IBA Library has two premises one at the Main Campus in KU enclave and one at the City Campus in Saddar. These premises aspire to support teaching, learning and research at the institute by developing and promoting systems and resources essential for access to relevant information. The libraries offer innovative and customized information services to encourage and synthesize thoughts for transfer of knowledge.

The Libraries at both of the campuses are regularly updated with latest learning materials like books, case-studies, online resources (*e-books and e-journals*). Around 4000 new titles, on average, are added every year to the library collections. Specialized information sources like research published by the educational institutions; National and International Research Organizations; and government agencies are also collected to facilitate indigenous research.

Facilities exist for campus-wide and remote access to a very rich collection of multi-disciplinary digital databases in full-text, consisting of e-books; e-journals. Case studies; and industry related research analysis reports, enrich the core of the offerings. Currently, the libraries subscribe to more than 24 electronic databases, which provide access to around 10000 e-journals and 1,25,000 e-books.



Mr. Mian Mohammad Abdullah is the founder Chairman of Sapphire Group which is among the largest business groups in the country. The group deals with businesses in vertical textiles ranging from spinning to knitted garments, woven garments, home textiles, work wear, denim and retail. It also operates the most efficient thermal IPP in Pakistan. The first wind IPP of the Group is expected to achieve COD this month with other initiatives to follow. The Group also operates a state of the art Dairy plant in the country.

In his life Mian Abdullah has faced tremendous challenges. On the independence of Pakistan, the family lost its leather business in Calcutta. Later with the breakup of Pakistan in

1971, the family had to leave behind its textile operations in erstwhile East Pakistan and start afresh in West Pakistan with the launch of Sapphire.

Mr. Abdullah and his ancestors have left their mark in terms of their contributions and support for the wellbeing and general development of society too. The Islamia Hospital building in Calcutta, along with numerous educational initiatives in the erstwhile East Pakistan and the number of initiatives which the Abdullah Foundation is presently taking stand testimony to the ever growing commitments of the family towards welfare of the society. In field of health and education the Abdullah Foundation's has invested in numerous projects in the country. As a founder member of the Citizens Foundation, Mr. Abdullah, was among the first few to sponsor a Citizen's Foundation School. He has also extended support to other institutions including, LUMS, Cardiovascular Institute in Karachi, Jinnah Hospital Lahore, Kidney Center, NICD Lahore etc. Presently, the reconstruction and refurbishment of the main campus Library at IBA is a venture the Abdullah family is very proud of.

The Abdullah Foundation hopes to continue to invest in health care and education to improve lives of people in this country.




